To ask the Minister for Health if a response will issue to Cumas, Co. Wexford in respect of a funding application; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

**Dear Deputy Kehoe** 

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

The national Framework for the Resumption of Adult Disability Day Services and the Guidance to support that framework provides clarity in regards that there may be requirements to reduce capacity in respect of individual services received by clients to ensure services continue to be delivered as safely as possible in the context of COVID and to the fact that the quantum of service provided to any individual may be reduced as service providers have to operate within COVID guidance.

The Local Disability Team are currently reviewing all day services across the South East in the context of additional funding received to enhance day services. Cumas Services Wexford will be included as part of this work. The HSE Disability Service understand that it is a very difficult and challenging time for all clients and their families, including those who attend Cumas and we will continue to liaise with Cumas directly regarding additional resources are made available.
