I refer to your parliamentary question above to which I have been asked to provide a response.

CHI at Crumlin confirm from 2016 - 2020 it has 228 paediatric acute beds.

CHI at Tallaght confirm from 2016 to 2019 it had 55 paediatric beds.

CHI at Temple Street confirm from 2016 to 2018 it had 161 beds; from 2019 to 2020 it had 168 beds.
