CHI at Crumlin confirm the Divisional Nurse Manager with responsibility for Colorectal Services has developed a business case pertaining to this role. The business case has been forwarded to the Chief Operating Officer in Children's Health Ireland (CHI) following review by the Director of Nursing and Directorate Operations Lead in CHI at Crumlin.

The Business Case will be for consideration and submission to the HSE as part of the 2021 service planning process and CHI will await a decision from the HSE regarding funding.
