The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

# **Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services**

CAMHS services are designed for children and adolescents presenting with moderate to severe mental health disorders. There are a total of eight sector based community mental health teams in Cork, supported by Eist Linn, Child and Adolescent Inpatient Unit which is based in Bessborough, Cork. Child and Adolescent Mental Health Teams are multi-disciplinary with Medical, Nursing, Social Work, Occupational Therapy, Psychology, Speech and Language Therapy and Administration Staff. The multidisciplinary nature of the team is designed to ensure that children and adolescents are offered care and treatment for moderate to severe, and often complex, mental illness that requires a range of disciplines, skills and perspectives. The model of care is holistic and is based on a recovery approach. The following table outlines the total Whole Time Equivalent (WTE) psychology staffing assigned to each sector based team across Cork Mental Health Services:

### **Adult Mental Health Services**



Services for Adults are provided through General Adult Community Mental Health Teams. All teams are multidisciplinary with Medical, Nursing, Social Work, Occupational Therapy, Psychology and Administration Staff. Teams are led by Consultants in Psychiatry. The following table outlines the total WTE psychology staffing assigned to each sector based team across Cork Mental Health Services

In addition to the psychology staff assigned to each of the sectoral CAMHS and Adults teams as outlined above, there are also a number of other specialty teams within Mental Health Services which provide a service in the Cork area and which would have psychology staff assigned to them. These specialist teams include Psychiatry of Later Life, Early Intervention Psychosis, CAMHS Eating Disorder Team, Open Dialogue, Rehab, Mental Health Intellectual Disability and Home Based Treatment Teams.
