I refer to your recent parliamentary questions forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

Background to response to PQ

The first two parts of your parliamentary question have been directed to the Higher Education Authority and the Department of Health has instructed the HSE to respond to your question

## Assigned to HSE:

' the number (of graduate nurses /\*year 2 on payscale) that entered jobs in the public health service in tabular form;'

In response to the question above, all graduate nurses were offered contracts with the HSE subject to vacancy rates, agency and overtime conversion in their relevant years.

The Deputy should note that the data on the table below refers to nurses who are HSE employees –it does not include S38 (Voluntary Sector) or S39 agencies
