There are currently two day services in Co Meath who provide services for persons with physical and/or sensory disability, The Resource Centre RehabCare, Dunboyne, and Liscarton IWA, Navan which include ABI.

All services strive to operate under the New Directions model and provide services where possible connected to the person's locality, rather than attending a 'centre.'
