Dear Deputy Clarke

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outline response as follows.

We have presented the available data in the table below and captured the relevant questions in each of the columns. The Young Adult Mental Health Service (YAMHS) covers both Longford and Westmeath as part of the same consultant clinic and therefore the information provided below is for the two counties combined.

In respect of the request for information with regard to "the number of referrals that were not accepted by the service; and the number of referrals not accepted that were referred onwards to psychology or other pertinent services in the same period in tabular form", we do not maintain individual data on this, however in all cases where a referral is not accepted (because it does not meet the referral criteria), the GP of the service user is informed so that they can make an alternative appropriate referral if necessary.

If you require the data for Longford and Westmeath to be presented separately on a per county basis, this can be done but it will take more time, please advise if you wish for this information to be forwarded to you.
