To ask the Minister for Health when training services for patients with mental health challenges will be reopened; the reason for the delay in reopening these vital centres; and if an urgent intervention will be made on the matter

Dear Deputy Calleary,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

At the onset of the COVID -19 crisis, decisions were made to close a number of HSE day services in order to protect the health and safety of service users.

Over recent months the HSE has focused on service continuity and the necessary contingencies that will support service provision in a COVID 19 context which takes account of appropriate IPC / HPSC guidelines. In line with this, the Heads of Mental Health in each of the CHOs have examined their day service provision in terms of service user needs and the current resources available. They have also considered current IPC and HPSC guidance in the context of the current government COVID - 19 roadmap and the current incidence of COVID - 19 in their CHO.

This means that mental health day services are not discontinued at this time however there is local variation in terms of service delivery.
