Question: "To ask the Minister for Health the plans in place to allow for non-appointment drive through Covid-19 testing throughout Country Wexford; and if he will make a statement on the matter".

Dear Deputy Murphy,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response. There are no plans in place for non-appointment drive through Covid-19 testing throughout County Wexford. Covid-19 Community Testing Centres in County Wexford, as in all other counties in Ireland operate on an appointment only basis.

The HSE continually monitor the demand for testing on both a national and regional level and in order to ensure that Covid-19 testing is available to all persons quickly. As needed, increased capacity for testing is added. This is accomplished through adding testing capacity at testing centres, extension of testing centre opening hours and, as needed, the set-up of additional testing centres on a short term basis.

The HSE Covid-19 Community Testing Service is committed to the timely provision of safe, accessible, quality swabbing services within the community setting. Over the past seven days, the median end-to-end turnaround time in community settings was 2 days, 90% of all those tested in the community settings received their results within this timeframe. In over 94% of referrals people get an appointment same day or next day.

I trust this clarifies the issue you have raised.
