Dear Deputy Troy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

CT Scanner – Midland Regional Hospital Mullingar (MRHM) - A new CT scanner was funded from the HSE Equipment Replacement Programme (ERP) 2020 and installed in June this year and is operational.

MRI Scanner – Midland Regional Hospital Mullingar (MRHM) - Friends of the Hospital have raised the funding necessary to purchase the MRI scanner. The project is on track to go to tender this month and it is expected that work will commence on site in January 2021.
