Re: PQ 17676/21: To ask the Minister for Health if a comparison will be provided of Covid-19 incidence rates between the general settled population and the Traveller community (details supplied); and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cahill

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

Data were extracted from the Health Protection Surveillance Centre's (HPSC) Computerised Infectious Disease Reporting System (CIDR) on April 9th 2021 at 7:30 am. CIDR is a dynamic system and case details may be updated at any time. Therefore, the data described here may differ from previously reported data and data reported for the same time period in the future. Population data were taken from Census 2016. Estimates for Irish travellers are likely underestimated as ethnicity was not captured by National Contact Tracing System (CMP) until June 10th 2020, and is not always volunteered at interview.

<u>Inclusion criteria for Irish Travellers:</u>

Covid-19 cases linked to outbreaks reported as affecting Irish Travellers OR whose ethnicity is reported as Irish Traveller, as of midnight April 8th2021.
