– “To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons that had an appointment for vaccination at the Aviva Stadium, Citywest Convention Centre, Helix Theatre, and TU Dublin campus, respectively on 24 March 2021; the number of persons who did not attend the appointment at each of these centres on that date; and if he will make a statement on the matter.”

Dear Deputy Hourigan,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Questions which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position

The total number of vaccine doses administered in each of those sites on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March is below:

Centre Name	Date administered	Number of doses
Aviva Stadium Vaccination Centre	24/03/2021	238
Citywest Convention Centre Vaccination Centre	24/03/2021	551
Helix Theatre	24/03/2021	0
TU Dublin campus	24/03/2021	0

Please note, most of the mass vaccination clinics started vaccinating on the 20<sup>th</sup> of April. Before that date, there is no data available on appointments in general. However, some of those site locations were administering vaccinations on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March, as reported above. The TU Dublin Campus is currently not used as a vaccination centre
