Thank you for your representation. As of Monday 3rd May, 1,621,870 vaccine doses have been administered; this information is updated daily and available at the following link: https://covid-19.geohive.ie/pages/vaccinations

As displayed at the above link, the below figures, as of Monday 3rd May are specific to those within the Government's provisional allocation cohort 4; People aged 16-69 years and at very high risk of severe COVID-19 disease.

Cohort 4 - 1st Dose	204, 271
Cohort 4 – 2nd Dose	5,799

It is important to emphasise that vaccination is only one part of our response to the prevention of COVID-19 infection.
