Thank you for your representation. The HSE continues to rollout the vaccination programme in line with the National Immunisation Advisory Committee (NIAC) guidance. The rollout of the vaccine programme to the 60-69 age group has seen a total of 253, 722 doses of vaccines administered through the vaccination centres as of the 9th May.
