PQ19720/21 To ask the Minister for Health the <u>number vaccinated</u> in a mass vaccine center (Breaffy House); the <u>number of cancellations</u>; the <u>number of no shows</u> within each group in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Mr Dillon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question/Public Representation which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

As of the 29<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 4,047 vaccinations were administered in Breaffy house. A further 232 people cancelled their scheduled appointments, 56 did not attend and did not cancel, and 82 were eligible for vaccine but not medically suitable for same. All patients who
