**PQ 19753-21 To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons who fall into the very high risk and high risk category as per the Covid-19 vaccine roll-out; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Neale Richmond**

Dear Deputy Richmond

Thank you for your query. As there is no central disease repository, and the HSE is working with community and acute services to identify locally those within the cohorts referred to, 4 and 7, I am unable to advise on the number of persons within these categories.

As you know, the vaccine programme is an opt-in service but as of Monday 3rd May, 1,621,870 vaccine doses have been administered; this information is updated daily and available at the following link: <https://covid-19.geohive.ie/pages/vaccinations>

As displayed at the above link, the below figures, as of Monday 3rd May are specific to those within the Government's provisional allocation cohort 4; People aged 16-69 years and at very high risk of severe COVID-19 disease.

Total doses offered to those in cohort 4	210, 270
Cohort 4 - 1st Dose	204, 271
Cohort 4 – 2nd Dose	5,799
Total doses offered to those in cohort 7	1,350
Cohort 7 - 1st Dose	1,348
Cohort 7 – 2nd Dose	2
