Details Supplied: Home from Home and Resilience Care

Dear Deputy Healy-Rae,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Resilience have confirmed there are no delays in signing an agreement. Resilience are ready to sign a lease but firstly the service provider needs to engage with the afterschool service provider “Home from Home” on requirements.

Disability Services are aware that “Home from Home” is an afterschool service provider that had service provision taken over by Resilience Healthcare which resulted in “Home from Home” board reverting to a landlord status. In addition, “Home from Home” received funding for the location from An Pobal. Therefore, the HSE are not part of that funding arrangement.

I trust this clarifies the situation for you.
