PQ 19994-21: Deputy David Cullinane: To ask the Minister for Health the target of vaccine delivery in estimated numbers of doses per week for each of the mass vaccination centres for each month in April, May and June 2021; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

Thank you for your representation. Apologies for the delayed response which is due to the HSE cyberattack. The HSE is rolling out the vaccine programme in line with the National Immunisation Advisory Committee guidance (NIAC). As of the 28th of July there has been 5,726,222 vaccines cumulatively administered, with 3,039,962 Dose 1s, and 2,477,226 Dose 2s and 209,034 single doses.

As of the week of the 26th of July there were, 144,734 vaccines administered. There is an expectation to administer between 200,000 and 230,000 vaccines next week (week beginning the 2nd of August). This is dependent on demand, uptake and activities in walk-in clinics which open this weekend

I hope this provides you with assistance.
