Re: PQ 21405/21 To ask the Minister for Health the number of those reported to Deputies as having died with Covid-19 at a HSE mid-west briefing on 26 March 2021, that had Covid-19 recorded as the disease or condition directly leading cause of death; and, in the said number of cases in which Covid-19 was recorded as the disease or condition directly leading to death, the number that had other significant conditions contributing to the death recorded.

Dear Deputy McNamara

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

As of 11th May:

There have been 397 deaths in the Mid-West due to COVID-19 since the beginning of pandemic. All data is provisional and subject to final verification.
