Details Supplied: The GAA Complex at Carrigoon Mallow Co Cork was designated as a vaccine centre by the HSE. I wish to know how much money has been dispersed by the HSE to the complex at Carrigoon, Mallow, to operate the vaccine centre, whether there was a written contract in place and all other relevant information relating to this successful project, delivered in the public interest.

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The HSE entered into a licence agreement with the Mallow GAA club for the use of their facility as a vaccination centre for the period of use (i.e. February 2021 to November 2021).

For the use of the facility, the HSE paid the club a figure of €235,300 for the period February to November 2021.

The HSE is grateful to Mallow GAA club for the use of their facilities. The vaccination centre has operated successfully and contributed significantly to the successful roll out of the vaccination programme in the North Cork area.
