Cork Kerry Community Healthcare has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for response.

The four bedroomed Cope Foundation house has been purchased in order to process the delivery of a seven day service. Extensive refurbishment works have taken place on the premises and are near completion. A recent update from the COPE Foundation is that the works are at the snagging stage.

Cope Foundation are planning a significant recruitment drive specifically for the West Cork area in the coming weeks to respond to staff shortages across all areas.

We await a further update from the COPE foundation and will update you further on the above and will revert early next year.
