Question: To ask the Minister for Health the distribution of the booster vaccines to General Practitioners by county in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Clarke,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

Each GP distributes the vaccine received and places orders accordingly. Please see the below table showing the number of booster orders (in vials and doses) placed by GPs in each county, up to close of business on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2021. The table is sorted in order of size with the county ordering the largest number of vials/doses first through to the county with the smallest number ordered.
