Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

By way of context, the data provides relates to NAS vehicles and includes all patient journeys including Emergency Ambulance, Intermediate Care and Critical Care and Retrieval Services as we are not in a position to segregate patient journeys by type.

In relation to **PQ60972/21**, please note that 20 minutes is not a standard which is applicable to NAS.

In relation to the following questions:

In relation to **PQ60977/21**, please note that a trip is equal one job cycle time, i.e. the time from mobilisation of resource to incident scene to patient handover at hospital.
