I refer the above representation to the Health Service Executive (HSE) and my reply below refers.

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In the first instance staffing pertaining to Dublin Fire Brigade (DFB) is a matter for Dublin City Council (DCC) as the employer and not the HSE/NAS as such, we cannot comment on the operations of DCC/DFB.

I attach a document for your information as requested the monthly Analytics reports issued by the HSE HBS Business intelligence unit, please note that this report is in arrears of a month, this is due to the way HSE employees are paid.

These reports detail HR and Pay costs attributable to the organisation Units of the NAS and also please Note, the Payroll Analysis & Forecasted Costs report is inclusive of Accruals.
