The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

If a women has severe menopausal symptoms she should consult her primary care physician in the first instance who should then discuss the various therapeutic options, which may include HRT if clinically indicated.
