The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

As you are aware, a wide range of emergency, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation services are provided in Ireland's public hospitals. National specialist services include heart, lung and liver transplants, bone marrow transplants, spinal injuries, paediatric cardiac services and medical genetics.

I wish to advise you that the information you have requested is not collated centrally. However, details of the service provision by hospital is published on each hospital website where it is updated regularly with information relating to the service impact of Covid 19.
