Dear Deputy Carey,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Following receipt of the final grant of planning in early March 2021, the design team have commenced on the detailed design and preparation of the procurement documents for the project. Provision of funding for this design work has already been provided in the HSE Capital Plan in 2021. It is planned to have the project tendered and a preferred contractor selected by the end of 2021. The construction period from contractor appointment would be approximately eighteen months.

The funding allocation in the following years will be subject to capital funding availability for the works within the future Health Capital vote at national level.
