“To ask the Minister for Health if locations other than those in the city of Cork will be considered in the event of a mass vaccination programme for County Cork to ensure that persons from west, north and east of the city will be accommodated for vaccinations within their geographical areas.”

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I wish to confirm that a number of locations in Cork and Kerry have been considered for mass COVID-19 vaccination centres by the Local Integrated Vaccination Working Group which consists of the South/South West Hospital Group (SSWHG) Cork-Kerry Community Healthcare (CKCH) and Estates.

These locations have been forwarded to the National Vaccine Committee which is responsible for co-ordinating the roll-out of the COVID-19 vaccination programme.

Priority locations are being developed by this group and direction is expected in the coming weeks.

I trust this information is of some assistance.
