Dear Deputy O'Reilly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Unfortunately, Community Healthcare Organisation - Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) do not have the resources in order to collate the information required in the format requested. However, the numbers listed below are taken from the staff census collated in January 2021.

Any employee with CHO DNCC may come into direct contact with Under 18s in their day-to-day duties. All Primary Care staff must complete mandatory training as part of Children's First which promotes the safety of children.
