PQ 9057/21: To ask the Minister for Health if his Department has conducted a workforce census of the entire public and private health and social care system; the breakdown or estimates of workers across categories of service providers; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing numbers which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

The HSE conducts a monthly census of public health services employment for covering the HSE and Section 38 Voluntary Hospitals & Agencies. The Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC) is the official employment count for the public health sector and is routinely published at https://www.hse.ie/eng/staff/resources/our-workforce/workforce-reporting/. Private healthcare providers fall under the aegis of the Department of Health and the HSE is unable to respond to this element of your query.

The Deputy will be interested to note that, at 31st January 2021, there were 126,689 WTE (equating to 145,842 personnel) directly employed in the provision of Health and Social Care Services by the HSE and the various Section 38 organisations. These latest available figures represent a 6,872 (+5.7%) WTE increase over the course of December 2019 outturn. Details are as follows:
