"To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons awaiting appointments under the National Counselling Service in County Cork; the waiting times for each service for CaPA, CIPC and counselling for former residents of mother and baby homes; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Toibín,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above extensive list of Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In relation to HSE Mental Health Services, access to counselling services is provided through Counselling in Primary Care. This service is available for people over the age of 18 years, or those who hold a medical card and who experience mild to moderate psychological difficulties. It is a short-term counselling service that provides counselling sessions with a professionally qualified and accredited Counsellor/Therapist.

Those who experience moderate to severe mental health issues can also access a psychosocial nurse through their GP and they will typically be seen within two weeks or sooner if the referral is deemed urgent.
