PQ 9299/21 – "To ask the Minister for Health the projected date by which every nursing home will have received the second dose of the Covid-19 vaccine; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Questions which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position

It is expected that all nursing homes will have received their dose 2s by the end of March. Mop up clinics are currently underway in nursing homes to facilitate vaccination of individuals who could not receive their vaccination on the original vaccination session day, due to outbreaks of COVID or personal circumstances. It is expected this process will also be completed by the end of March.
