Reference your enquiry referred to myself on 07.01.21 in regard to the manner in which neurological service referrals are prioritised.

Outpatient


- GP / tertiary referrals for consultation are triaged by designated Consultant and given an appointment that gives cognisance to perceived clinical urgency identified and, the need for chronological order.

Hospital → Hospital inpatient transfers - predominantly neurosurgery

- referrals can be made on a 24/7 basis and where necessary including appropriate MRI / CT scans undertaken within the referring hospital.
- based on the appropriateness for clinical intervention, patients are transferred to the hospital.

Key access time targets in this regard are:

- Traumatic Brain Injury admitted to unit within 12 hours of acceptance (100% target)
- Sub-arachnoid haemorrhage admitted with 24 hours of acceptance (90% target)
- Space Occupying Lesion admitted within 5 working days of acceptance (90% target)



- during 2020 the hospital exceeded each of these referral access targets.
