The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to this Department for response.

The total Temporary Assistance Payment Scheme (TAPS) payments made as at the 26/01/2021 was €65,200,621.

A breakdown of payments on a geographical basis is provided in Appendix A.

The total number of nursing homes that received TAPS payments as at the 26/01/21 was 444.

Funding under the TAP Scheme is payable to private and voluntary nursing homes only.

I hope this clarifies the position.
