PQ 2989/21: To ask the Minister for Health the number of new appointments made by county; the speciality and location of these appointments by county; and the number of appointments that are permanent arising from the Winter Initiative by county in tabular form.

Dear Deputy Calleary,

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing numbers which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

Health services employment is reported on a monthly basis through the Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC) which is the official employment count for the public health sector covering the HSE and Section 38 Voluntary Hospitals & Agencies. At 31st December 2020, there were 126,174 WTE (equating to 144,113 personnel) directly employed in the provision of Health and Social Care Services by the HSE and the various Section 38 organisations. These latest available figures represent a 6,357 (+5.3%) WTE increase over the course of 2020.

Information in this response is as per the staff category and staff groupings assigned in HSPC returns with numbers equating to service levels expressed as whole time equivalents (WTE) taking account of part-time working and headcount equating to the number of individuals and on the basis of the seven hospital groups and nine community care areas. It is not feasible to represent this information on a county basis and the catchment areas of these organisations cross county boundaries.

For the Deputy's information, the following table below sets out the additional number of directly employed workers in whole-time equivalence terms over the course of 2020.
