The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outline the position as follows.

Older People in Co. Meath have access to a number of integrated care services, including home support service, respite service, day service and long term care. Older Person Services provided integrated care to clients in Co. Meath with public health nursing service and other Primary Care Services including community physiotherapy service, community occupational therapy, community podiatry service and other primary care services.
