\* To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons who have been waiting for oncology appointments in County Cork for six, 12 and over 24 months, respectively-Thomas Gould

Dear Deputy Gould,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. We have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The South/ South West Hospital Group(S/SWHG) can confirm that there are no cancer patients waiting for an oncology appointment in County Cork for six, 12 and over 24 months.

The S/SWHG has undertaken substantial work to manage the effect of Covid-19 on cancer services and overall activity and additional capacity has been generated through a variety of means such as insourcing (out of hours capacity), use of the private hospital arrangement and National Treatment Purchase Fund (NTPF) funding.

A dedicated team supported by the Group and the National Clinical Programme for Surgery (NCPS) have commenced work at exploring further ways to expand theatre resources and ensure timely access to surgery for patients over the forthcoming weeks and months. The full resumption and development of theatre activity and cancer services is a priority for S/SWHG, however, this will be dependent on the transmission rates of COVID-19 in the community and the resulting pressures on acute services.
