PQ 12138/21 - To ask the Minister for Health the number of doses of a vaccine (details supplied) that have been delivered to Ireland to date; the number of those doses that have been delivered to administering locations; and if he will provide a full complete schedule of locations in which the vaccines will be delivered.

Dear Deputy Murphy,

Thank you for your representations. To date there has been 818,160 doses of vaccine delivered to Ireland up to the 18th of March. As of last Friday 19th March 2021, 668,529 vaccines have been administered nationally; this information is available [here](#).

Vaccines have been administered across a range of settings, within acute hospital settings, communities, GPs, Mass Vaccination Clinics such as the Helix in DCU or one of 38 vaccination centres around the country. These vaccination centres can be found in the link below.

<https://www.gov.ie/en/publication/8a35f-irelands-covid-19-vaccination-centres/>. Vaccination centres are open to vaccinate the current cohorts, there are 13 currently open and the numbers open will increase based on vaccine supply.
