Attached please find information on major capital works and associated costs supplied by Cappagh Hospital. Please note these projects were part funded by the HSE. The HSE funding was as follows: €250k for the 'Development of New Admissions Building at Front of Hospital and €460k for the 'Refurbishment of an old Convent Building into a Paediatric Orthopaedic Out-Patient Clinic.
