Dear Deputy Ó Murchú

Thank you for your representation. Frontline healthcare workers are included in group 2 of the National Immunisation Advisory Committee (NIAC) vaccine allocation strategy. Correspondence was issued to frontline healthcare workers in early February in relation to registering on the vaccine registration portal, the information is available in the following link

Once a healthcare worker registers they identify the area they are working in being community or hospital. They will then be contacted directly with an appointment to receive a vaccine.
