PQ13662/21: To ask the Minister for Health the number of first year students who received the first dose of the HPV vaccine from September to December 2018; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Kelly,

The above PQ has been forwarded to my Department for direct response to you on same.

22,484 girls in first year in second level schools were vaccinated with the first dose of HPV vaccine between the 1st September and 31st December 2018.

The numbers offered the vaccine in the academic years 2018/19 to 2020/21, the numbers vaccinated between the 1st September and 31st December and the uptake rate of the first dose in this time period are shown in Table 1.

data currently on the School Immunisation System is an estimate only and will be updated when the numbers are finalised.

5.The 2020/21 numbers immunised reflect data recorded on the system, however, more children may have been immunised than currently recorded e.g. if data entry staff were redeployed to work on COVID-19 vaccinations
