Thank you for your query.

To apply for a European Health Insurance Card, evidence of a person's name, address, date of birth, and Personal Public Service (PPS) Number. Those applying for a European Health Insurance Card via Irish authorities may also be asked to provide proof that they are ordinarily resident in Ireland.
