PQ Ref 15636/21: To ask the Minister for Health the number of breast pumps available in each maternity unit.

Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The HSE is committed to supporting, promoting and protecting breastfeeding and optimum infant feeding practices for all mothers and babies. The HSE's Infant Feeding Policy for Maternity and Neonatal Services outlines the clinical practices and supports for optimising breast milk when mothers and babies are unable to feed directly from the breast.

Each hospital provides mothers with access to a hospital grade breast pump when needed and there are 225 hospital grade breast pumps available for use in postnatal and neonatal services. A minimum of 57 hospital grade breast pumps are available to loan to mothers of sick or premature babies admitted to Neonatal intensive care units and where the mother is discharged from hospital.

The table overleaf outlines the latest available information on the total number of breast pumps available in each maternity hospital/unit.
