The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in relation to the above parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have consulted with the National Renal Office on your question and have been informed that the following outlines the position.


Currently, there are 9 HSE Contracted Haemodialysis units nationally supplied by 3 providers. These units allow for growth in capacity and expansion of dialysis services in Ireland with the provision of services closer to patients home at a local level, consistent with safe and effective care and practice.

- In 2019 - The number of haemodialysis patients treated in HSE Contracted centres was 594
- In 2020 - The number of haemodialysis patients treated in HSE Contracted centres was 678
- In 2021 to date (End of Feb 2021) - The number of haemodialysis patients treated in HSE Contracted centres was 692
