The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parlimentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The COVID-19 vaccine registration portal opened for frontline healthcare workers to register for their vaccine on 12th February 2021. This included all frontline healthcare workers working in HSE or HSE-funded organisations, Private hospitals and clinics, Community based not-for-profit and private healthcare providers.

I wish to advise you that all of the front-line healthcare workers in Cope Foundation have been offered their vaccinations.
