“To ask the Minister for Health the number of HSE paediatric pain specialists his plans to increase same; and if he will make a statement on the matter”.

Dear Deputy Durkan,

I refer to your parliamentary question above to which I have been asked to provide a response.

The Complex Pain service is transitioning to a new model of rehabilitative Multidisciplinary care following the recent appointments.

There is currently a Locum Consultant Anaesthesiologist with a special interest in Pain providing 2 sessions per week to CHI with respect to Complex Pain. An Acute or Complex Pain specialist is usually appointed on the basis of being a Consultant Anaesthesiologist with a special interest in Pain. As such, these Consultants have a sessional commitment to Anaesthesiology and a sessional commitment to Pain services as well.

The recruitment process underway and advertised is for two full-time Consultant Anaesthesiologists (with a special interest in Pain), with both posts constructed to have a 0.5 Whole Time Equivalent (WTE) structured commitment to the Pain Service.
