Dear Deputy Farrell

Thank you for your representation. As of the 6th of April there were 961,887 vaccines administered; Over 679,000 people have now received the first dose of their vaccine. The Vaccine Programme Roll Out crossed the 1 million threshold on 8th April. The HSE achieved the highest week administering over 126,000 doses over the week of 29th March, with Good Friday achieving the highest daily total administering over 31,000. As you will be aware NIACs provided updated advice to the Department of Health yesterday. Please see link below for more information.
