**PQ 16240 /21 - To ask the Minister for Health the cohorts that are being vaccinated at the Helix, DCU; the average number each day that are being vaccinated on site; and if he will make a statement on the matter. - Róisín Shortall**

Deputy Shortall,

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your PQ which has been passed to us for response.

The GP-led Clinic at the Helix is vaccinating cohorts in line with the GP delivered over 70s program. There is no average as each clinic deals with an increasing number of patients in line with the population size by age cohort from the 116 participating Practices.

- Clinic 1 vaccinated 1,007 over 85s
- Clinic 2 vaccinated approx 1,456 80-84
- Clinic 3 vaccinated approx 3,650 patients including the 1,007 Dose 2 Vaccines for the Over 85s, with the remainder being those aged 75-79
- Clinic 4 anticipates vaccinating approx 6,500 patients, such patients being the 1,456 Dose 2 recipients in the age group 80-84 and approx 5,000 dose 1 recipients in the age group 70-74
- Clinic 5 will provide dose 2 for those aged 75-79
- Clinic 6 will be for dose 2 for those aged 70-74
