PQ 16649/21 To ask the Minister for Health the date on which nursing homes were fully vaccinated. –

Dear Deputy Tóibín

Thank you for your representation. Dose 1 vaccination for cohort 1 (those aged over 65 in Residential Care Facilities) is almost complete across the country. There are a small number of individuals (less than 100) who will receive vaccination through mop up clinics. These are individuals who could not avail of a vaccine due to outbreaks. A breakdown by county is not available but at a national level, as of March 21st, the total number Dose 1 vaccination administered is 107,168 while 77,056 people have received their Dose 2. Remaining Dose 2 vaccinations will continue in March 2021.

A plan to ensure new residents to Nursing Homes are vaccinated, for the month of April and possibly into early May, is currently being prepared.
