To ask the Minister for Health the number of doses of Covid-19 vaccine by type held in storage (the number of doses of Covid-19 vaccine by type that is Pfizer, Moderna and AstraZeneca held in storage at the Aviva Stadium, Citywest Convention Centre, Helix Theatre and TU Dublin Campus as at 24 March 2021) as of 24 March 2021; if such data can be updated regularly on the Covid-19 data hub; and if he will make a statement on the matter. - Neasa Hourigan

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.
